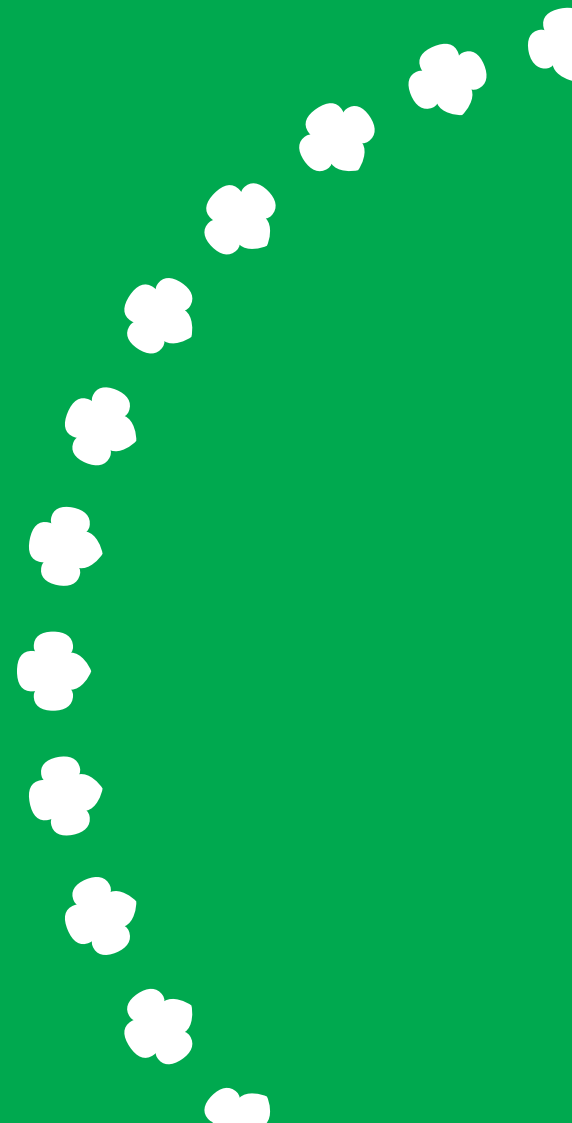

The Year in Review

Through the 2009-2010 fiscal year, Girl Scouts of California's Central Coast (GSCCC) continued the organizational journey that began in 2007 with the merger of the Monterey Bay and Tres Condados legacy councils. A landmark event was the first Annual Meeting of the new council, held in February, 2010 in Santa Maria. A pilot Gold Award Recognition Event was held and the council submitted a proposal to Girl Scouts of the USA that encourages the Girl Scout Movement to create language to focus the Gold Award on the girl who earns it rather than the award itself. Representatives from the council participated in National Strategy and STEM Initiatives, Alumnae Studies, and Leadership Alliances. Five GSCCC troops participated in destination travel locations to Europe, Spain, France, Washington DC and a GSCCC Girl Scout was selected as a representative to go to Ireland

Financially, revenue for the year exceeded expenses by \$261,859. At a time when many councils are in deficit spending, the financial stability of GSCCC will allow the council to invest in strategic processes and initiatives to achieve sustainable membership growth, including recruiting and supporting more volunteers. The positive financial results were due to a combination of discipline around expenses, and growth in product sales and fund development

Although 2009-2010 was the seventh consecutive year of membership decline for Girl Scouting overall, GSCCC membership was flat for the year. To enable improved support systems for membership, the registrar function was moved to Finance and a Single Entry System position was created. Service Unit training was attended by 28 of the council's 33 Service Units. Kaleidoscope participation exceeded 2000. Brownlympics was held in four locations with more than 1500 in attendance.

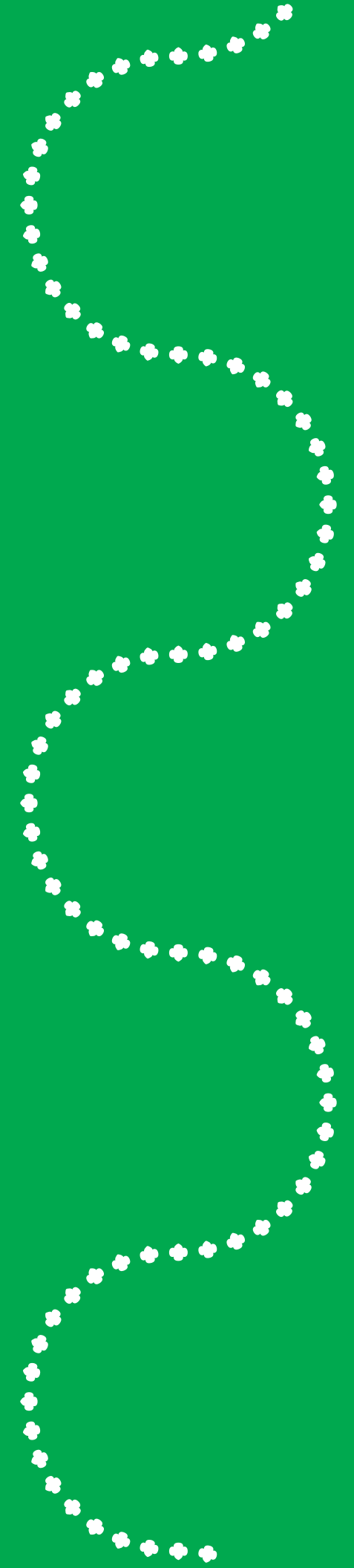

PROGRAM PATHWAYS

While the majority of girls experienced Girl Scouting in traditional troops led by an amazing corps of volunteer leaders, the council continued to integrate Program Pathways to give girls options for their participation in Girl Scouting with series, events, camp, and travel. In all, approximately 3,500 Girl Scout members were served by one or more volunteer or staff-led events in 2010. Troops also continued to schedule their own excursions and activities through our council-approved DISCOVER PROGRAMS. Program highlights for the year include:

STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering and Math)

To meet the growing need for skilled female science and technology professionals, a variety of STEM based series and events were held to allow girls to explore these worlds in a fun and motivating way. Girl Scout's leadership journey curriculum gave the foundation for girls to explore STEM and earn awards with programs like: iRobot - the Mechanics of Movement, and Building a Better City for a Greener Environment. Also tied to journey's curriculum, the council's Daisy *Ladybug Club* - recognized at a national Girl Scouts of the USA program training event - provided a six-week series of learning about plants, ecology, composting, and more.

GSCCC's LEGO Robotics Team *The Imagineers* continued to compete for a second year. A summer STEM *Smart Girls* program was also held at Blackstock Junior High in Oxnard and at the Arnaz Program Center where girls learned about the science of cosmetics and experimented with electricity, solar energy, rockets, and chemistry.

Take Action Girl Forum

Linking Girls to the Outdoor Environment

Continuing a Girl Scout tradition, GSCCC offered girls an opportunity to have outdoor learning experiences. Popular events included: Camp Artemis - older girl resident leadership camp, horse camp, ski weekend, bike and BBQ, beach clean-up, surf camp, zoo snooze, and seven summer day camps hosted by our incredible volunteers.

Kaleidoscope 2010

A much anticipated and popular council hallmark event held in the beautiful outback of Santa Barbara every other year, Kaleidoscope 2010, *Venture into Space*, was held in April for the 13th time. With over 2000 in attendance, girls camped, competed in skill challenges, conducted a service project, danced to a jumbotron, and explored the night sky with a giant telescope provided by the Santa Barbara Astronomical Unit. Preparations started months before with a vol-

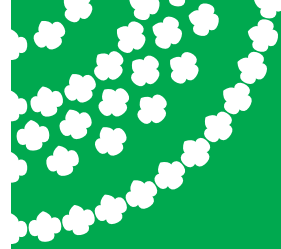


unteer event committee, while girls practiced skill-based challenges for earned awards. The skill challenges were loaded with learning-by-doing benefits including working in teams to compete for points, and utilizing new skills against the rigors of an outdoor environment.

Take Action Girl Forum:

Investigate, Prepare, Act, Reflect, Demonstrate, Celebrate, Sustain

Take Action, a key component of the Girl Scout Leadership Experience, helps girls understand and value the difference between a short-term community service project and a project with measurable long-term benefits. GSCCC was fortunate in 2010 to receive a grant which allowed our council to train volunteers and our ALTA (Artemis Leadership Training Adventure) program girl members, who in-turn, facilitated the Take Action Module with 47 girls between the ages of 14-16 at the Take Action Girl Forum in a break-out session during the 2010 Annual Meeting. The Forum focused on the steps to Take Action and the key role that measurability and sustainability play in Take Action projects.



Camp Arnaz Program Center

The council's beautiful 36-acre program facility remained a steady, constant friend in our southern region providing that special place where girls have a first overnight camp experience, and girls and troops reunite over and over to experience the fun and lifelong friendships of Girl Scouting. Hundreds of girls and individuals were served at Arnaz in 2010.

With required maintenance due, a "journey" of improvements for Camp Arnaz also began in 2010 with rainshine shelter repair, new mattresses in cabins and yurts, new trees with drip lines, along with progress toward a new showerhouse. Projects were funded by generous foundations and individual donors. Maintenance and other improvements will continue throughout the 100th Anniversary of Girl Scouting in 2012 and beyond.

Salinas Program Center

During 2009-2010, the Program Center served a total of 119 members, 115 girls and four adults, with an average of 35 girls each week. The leadership journey books were implemented, as well as Healthy Living workshops for girls. Workshops included: healthy foods and meals, hygiene and the daily routines, exercise your body and soul, and being a good sister to other Girl Scouts. Other activities included: crafts, drawing, photography, educational games, and interactive physical activity. During the first hour, girls routinely completed their homework – older girls provided leadership as homework aides. The Salinas Program Center continues to be primarily grant funded.

Community Collaborations

GSCCC continued to give girls access to Girl Scout programming through the generous contributions of foundations, individuals, and United Way, as well as community partners to provide collaborations at various school sites, recreation centers, housing authority locations, migrant camps, Salvation Army and Boys & Girls Clubs. In 2010, GSCCC provided program to 1,724 girls. Seventy-one afterschool/summer camp programs were also held. Our collaborations continued to focus on healthy development, self-esteem and emotional well-being, with programs such as STEM, *Uniquely ME!*, *Bridging the GAP*, and *Fun In the Sun*.



Cookie Sale

GSCCC's annual Girl Scout Cookie Program – the council's primary fundraiser and a financial literacy program for girls – saw a net increase of 5% in 2010, in line with the national average for Girl Scout councils. To kick-off and celebrate the Girl Scout Cookie season, GSCCC hosted its 1st Annual Cookie Rally and Bake-Off events in Ventura and San Luis Obispo Counties with celebrity chefs, parent/daughter teams, and a VIP panel of judges. Hundreds of Girl Scouts came together to launch this annual Girl Scout tradition. Girl Scout Cookie rallies were also held in Santa Barbara and Monterey counties.

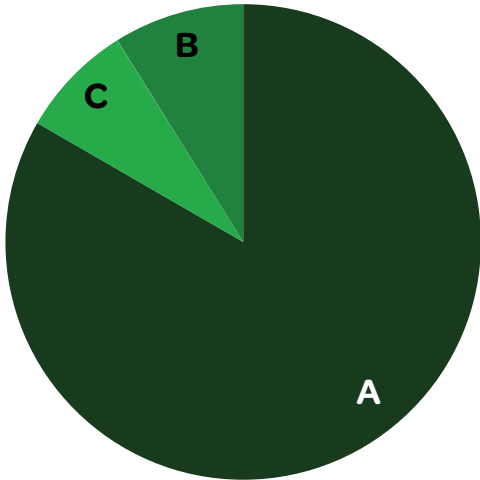

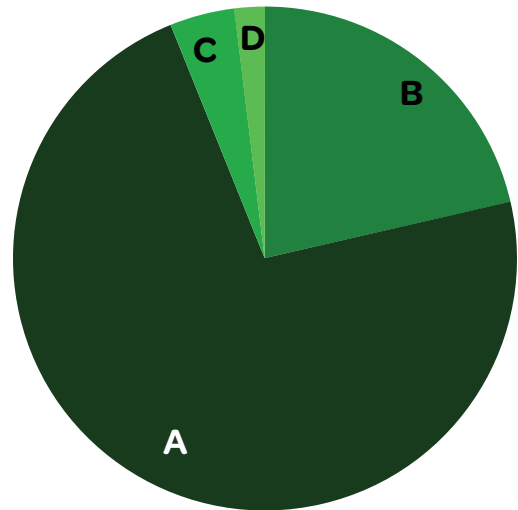
How Girl Scouts Used Resources Wisely

Girl Membership Racial Diversity

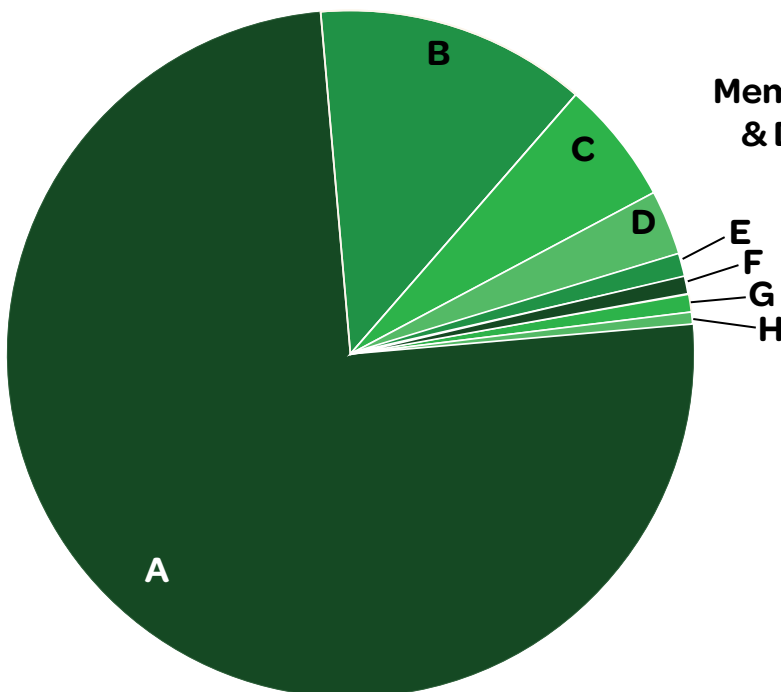

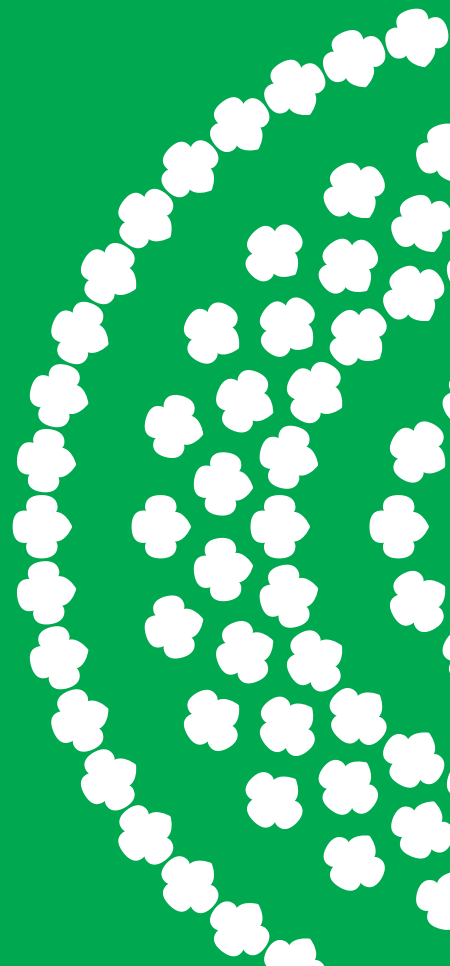

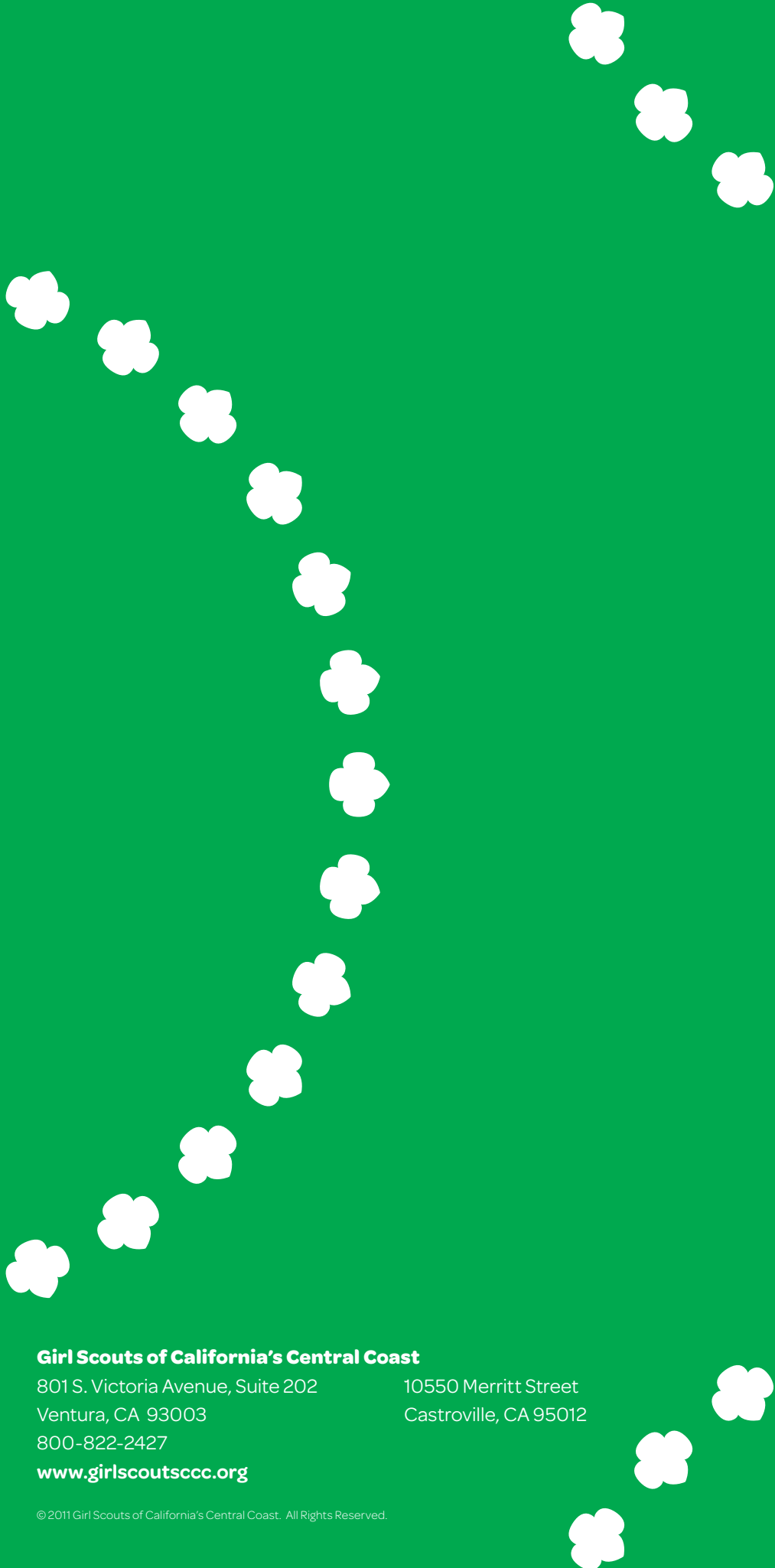
