- Wells Fargo will keep a master list of account numbers by troop number and leader names.
- Information to be communicated to troop leaders from the Girl Scouts:
 - Clarification of accounts to be opened [by mail](#).
****DO NOT GO TO A LOCAL BRANCH****
 - Completion of *Profile Information*
 - Completion of *Addendum of Certificate of Authority* (signature only)
 - \$100 opening deposit.
 - If your troop is experiencing financial hardship, please e-mail our CFO, for a GSCCC loan that we will collect on after cookie sales. Please contact our CFO at ksullivan@girlscoutsccc.org
 - What troop leaders can expect once the above has been mailed?
 - Accounts will be opened within the week the information is received
 - Leaders will receive a call from Ramon L. Campos our Business Banking Specialists, to welcome you and answer any questions you may have. They will also receive their account number at that time.
 - (the Council will receive notification of troop account numbers)
 - Troop Leaders will receive an ATM “Deposit-Only” card and PIN number. At that time, leaders will need to sign up for [online access](#) at www.wellsfargo.com for the online account statements-, which is the qualifier for a free account. (Further information available on the HELP card provided on how to log on to Well Fargo website.)
 - Wells Fargo will order the first box of checks (approx. \$20.00) and should arrive in 10 business days- we encourage you to decline the checks and use one of the online services provided in this packet.
 - Troop Numbers need to be on every sheet of paper for cross-reference.

Remember: DO NOT go to a local Branch to open your troop account. Accounts must be opened by mail.
