



Confetti Poppers!

Supplies:

- Toilet paper roll
- 12 inch balloons
- Decorative paper or markers
- Confetti (please use recyclable material, i.e. shredded newspaper)
- Scissors
- Tape

Directions:

1. Decorate your toilet paper roll however you like.
2. Cut your balloon in half and tie the end.
3. Once you're done decorating your tube, place the larger end of the balloon on one side of your tube. Use tape to secure it down.
4. Put a handful of confetti into your tube.
5. Pull back the balloon end and let go. Watch the confetti pop out!
