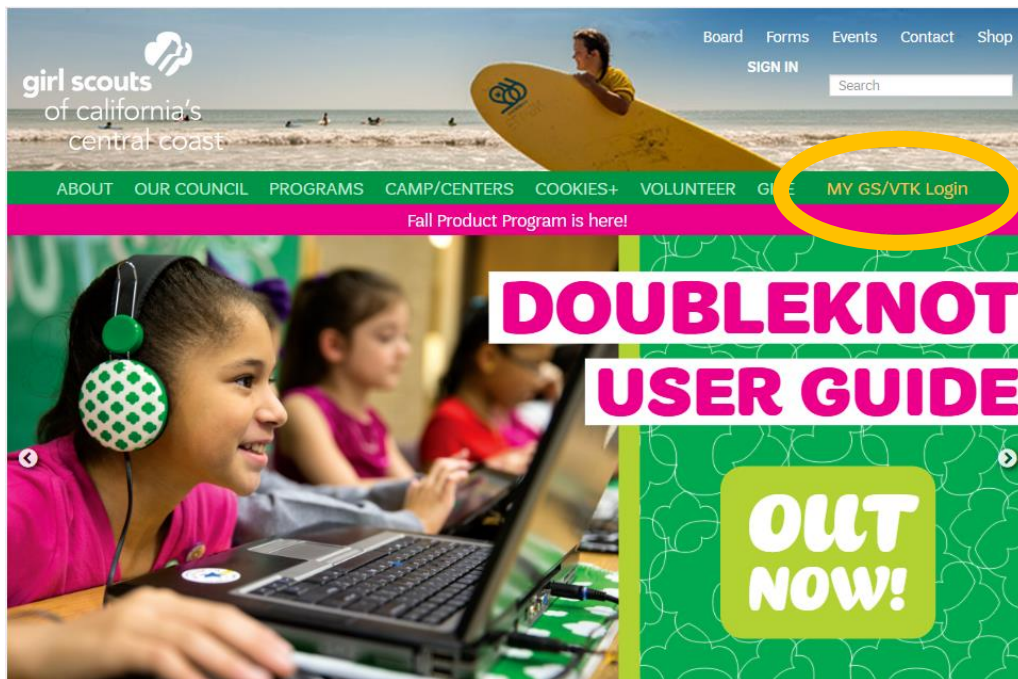


How to begin training in gsLearn

In order to access gsLearn, you will need to have a current Girl Scout membership and background check.

Step 1	Go to the council's webpage www.girlscoutscoc.org
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Step 2	<p>Click on the My GS ribbon (in yellow)</p> <p>You will be asked to enter your credentials. These are the same credentials you would use for the member community [myGS].</p> <p>Username is your email</p> <p>After you completed registration, you would have received an invitation email to the member community. The first time you log in, you would have been asked to create a password.</p> <p>After you enter credentials, Select GS Learn.</p>

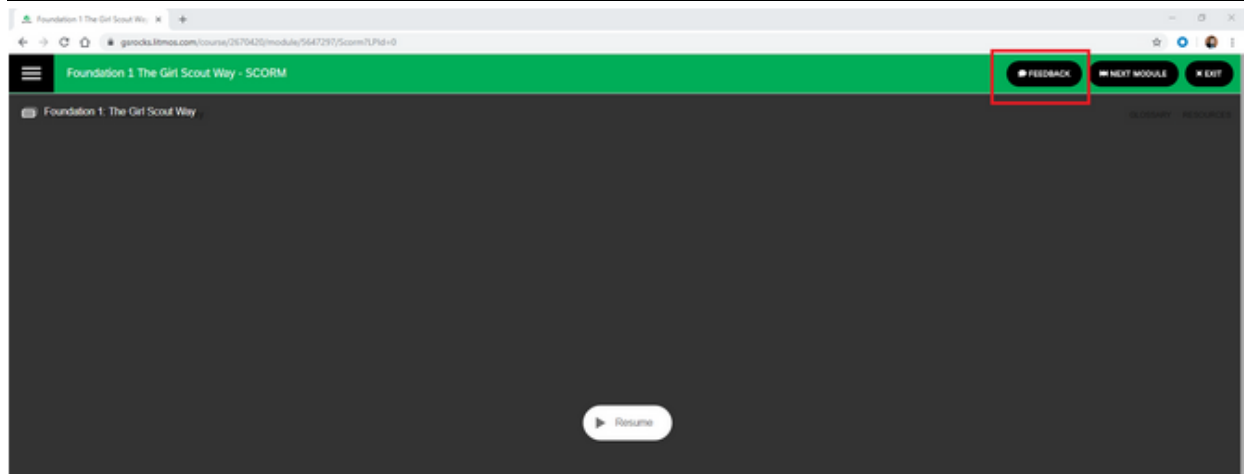

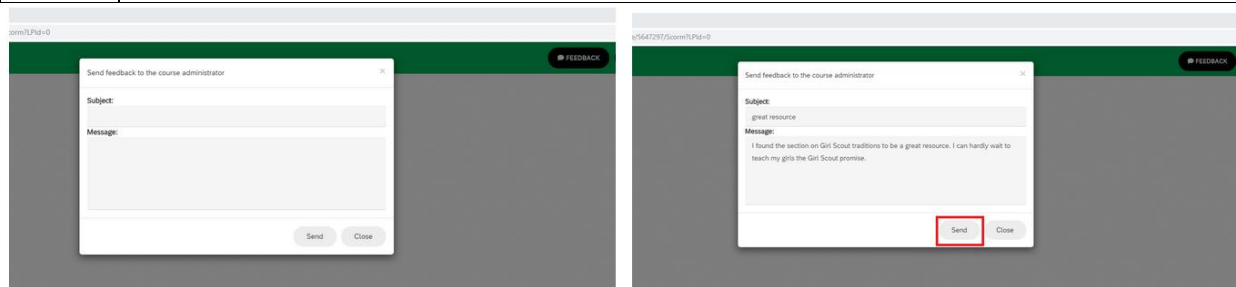
Step 3	You will enter the gsLearn site at your dashboard. You may want to update your profile and time zone at this time. It may take up to 30 minutes for your Learning Path to load and be available to begin.
Step 4	After logging in to gsLearn, the learner will land on (or navigate to) the home page. Assigned courses will appear on the "All" tab.

Step 5	Click on the module's tile that you wish to begin. That module/learning path will open on the next screen. Click on the link to the training file.
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Step 6	Click to begin the training.
Step 7	If you have feedback during the training module, click on the feedback button in the upper right corner. Not all trainings may include this option.



Step 8	A pop out will appear; complete with the information you would like to share. Click send when done.
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Feedback goes to the course administrator. For the nationally developed courses that is a GSUSA staff person.
