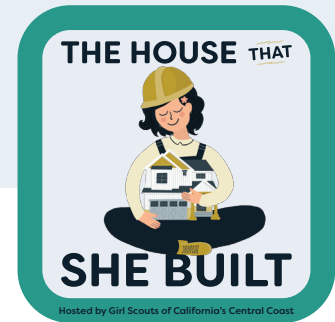




# THE HOUSE THAT SHE BUILT
