

The Property


Nestled in a unique section of the lower Ojai Valley and inland from the city of Ventura, Camp Arnaz is home to more than 36 acres of beautiful scenery and diverse outdoor recreational opportunities. Since its dedication in November of 1982, Girl Scouts, non-profit organizations, and private parties alike have enjoyed the picturesque landscape, enriching programs and special events at the Arnaz Special Events Center. Visitors can enjoy all that our property has to offer with its ample outdoor spaces and facilities to accommodate even the largest groups. The Arnaz Special Events Center is the perfect location for your next community event, team retreat, wedding reception, and more.

The Amenities

Enjoy camping in tents, yurts, or spacious cabins. Day use or overnight reservations are available. For bicycling enthusiasts, Camp Arnaz is located near the Ojai bike trail that reaches down to Ventura and its beautiful beachfront properties. Visitors can enjoy the volleyball and tetherball courts, participate in equine programs, or try their hand at archery in our fully equipped archery range



Nature Trail

Enjoy the nearby Sulphur Mountain Trail located just outside of the front gates. This trail is 11 miles of dirt road with tight switchbacks and fantastic views of the Ojai Valley and surrounding mountain ranges. Nature lovers will enjoy a variety of wildlife, which includes deer, coyotes, bobcats, foxes, red-tail hawks, rattlesnakes, tarantulas and roadrunners. A small number of private residences are just off the trail. Stay on the trail at all times and obey all "No Trespassing" signs.



Astronomy Center

The Astronomy Center is a space dedicated to engage Girl Scouts to explore the wonders of space and the universe. The center offers facilities for stargazing, telescope viewing, and educational programs for all ages, making it a great destination for Girl Scouts, families, school groups, and anyone interested in the mysteries of the cosmos.





Cabin: Pippin

Cabins include electricity, flush toilets, one shower stall, hot water, kitchen with sink, stove/oven, refrigerator, BBQs and fire pits, picnic tables, and tables and chairs by request. A small number of tents can be pitched on cabin lawns.

Cabin: Rome Beauty

Cabins include electricity, flush toilets, one shower stall, hot water, kitchen with sink, stove/oven, refrigerator, BBQs and fire pits, picnic tables, and tables and chairs by request. A small number of tents can be pitched on cabin lawns.

Capacity: 25 Overnight with bunk beds/mats for 14

Fuji & Gala Yurts

There are two yurts at Arnaz. Each canvas yurt has locking doors, concrete flooring, bunk beds with mats, outdoor fire pit, running water. No electricity.

Meeting/Activity Capacity: 25 Overnight/Camping Capacity: 14

Tents can be pitched around yurts:

- FUJI one or two small tents
- GALA several tents













Campsites/Rainshine Shelters

- (5) Rainshine campsites with sheltered cover. Capacity: 25

Camp Arnaz is the perfect central location for all group types and exploring both Ojai and Ventura. Check out the beautiful beaches and lakesides just a pleasant bike ride away, or take a quick drive to enjoy shopping, spas, wineries, and more!

- 6 minute drive to Old Creek Ranch & Winery (1.6 miles)
- 11 minute drive to Casitas Water Adventure a water park/family attraction (5.4 miles)
- 12 minute drive to Lake Casitas Recreation Area (5.4 miles)
- 13 minute drive to Ojai Valley Inn (6.2 miles)
- 13 minute drive to Main Street Ventura (8.2 miles)

- 16 minute drive to Soule Park Golf Course (7.9 miles)
- 16 minute drive to San Buenaventura State Beach (10.9 miles)
- 17 minute drive to Golf N Stuff (14.4 miles)
- 26 minute drive to Camarillo Premium Outlets (24 miles)

Camp History


Camp Arnaz was originally purchased by the Girl Scouts of Tres Condados (now Girl Scouts of California's Central Coast) in 1975. It was officially dedicated on November 18, 1982, and since then has served thousands of Girl Scouts and community members as a place of recreation and relaxation.

Camp Arnaz has been designated as a Monarch Breeding and Research Institute with pollinator gardens to help these beautiful creatures survive. It is also home to a variety of wildlife, including red-eared turtles, herons, fish, squirrels, owls, blue jays, swallows, woodpeckers, red tailed hawks and more!

- Camp Arnaz was originally an apple orchard.
- Camp Arnaz gets it's name from the nearby Rancho Arnaz which was once home to and famous for its apple orchards and apple juice.
- The cabins Pippin and Rome, as well as the Rainshines:
 Golden Delicious, Red Delicious, Winesap, Jonathan, and
 Pearmain are all named after types of apples.

Property Fun Facts

- Camp Arnaz is now home to a stone fruit orchard and an apple orchard that provides nectar for bees, butterflies, and hummingbirds.
- The loft area in the Rome Beauty cabin was once accessible by a permanently affixed steel ladder, due to safety concerns, this ladder was removed.
- The Arnaz Program Center hosts several annual events throughout the year for Girl Scouts, family, friends, and members of the community to enjoy.
- Girl Scouts of California's Central Coast's very own CEO, Tammie Helmuth, was married at Camp Arnaz.
