

Handprint Pirate

Supplies:

- White paper
- Black paper
- 1 googly eye (alternative: you can draw this on or make it out of paper)
- Black, red, white, and skin colored paint (alternative: other colors of paint, or markers/colored pencils/crayons)
- Scissors
- Tape or glue

Steps:

- 1. Paint all your fingers black except for the thumb
- 2. Paint the center of your palm with the skin colored paint
- Paint a red line on the bottom of your palm
 If you don't have paint: trace the shape of your hand onto the paper and fill in with color
- 4. Press your hand hard down onto a piece of white paper
- 5. When the paint dries, cut out a pirate hat out of your black paper (or draw it on)
- 6. Paint or draw a white skull and crossbones on the hat
- 7. Glue/tape the googly eye on (or draw it on) and paint or draw on a pirate's eye patch
- 8. Finish off the pirate by drawing/painting a big smile, and add "Girl Scouts is GRRReat!" at the bottom

Sink or Float Activity

Part 1: Sink or Float test

Materials:

- Large bowl half full of water
- Items to test
 - o Suggested: crayon, popsicle stick, small toy, coins, metal utensils, key, lemon, etc

Instructions:

- 1. Predict which items will sink and which will float
- 2. Test each item to see if you were correct

Part 2: Build a boat

Materials:

- Plastic container (empty food container, plastic cup, etc make sure it's clean)
 - OR cut a lemon in half, take one half, and scoop out the fruit. You can use the peel for the activity
- Playdough or clay
- Drinking straw, popsicle stick, or chopstick
- Paper
- Scissors





- Glue or tape
- Coloring materials (optional)
- Small toy (optional)

Instructions:

- 1. Cut a triangle out of your paper
- 2. Decorate it if you'd like
- 3. Glue or tape the triangle onto the top of your straw/stick, this will be your boat's mast and flag
- 4. Attach the straw/stick to the center of your container or lemon half using playdough or clay
- 5. Add your small toy, this is your boat's captain
- 6. Test to see if it will float!
